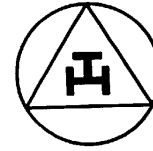
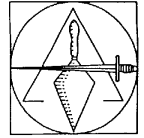
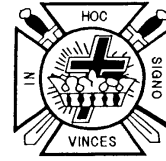

## Fall York Rite Festival

**The month of September has been the Fall York Rite Festival** for over twenty years. And traditionally, the Royal Arch Degrees have been conferred in Escondido by Tyre Chapter No. 130, on the second Saturday of the month with the participation of other Chapters in the County.

**There were a total of 11 Master Masons exalted to the Degree of Royal Arch Mason.**

Tyre Royal Arch Chapter No. 130 led the list with 4 new members. San Diego Royal Arch Chapter No. 61 was second with 3 new members. Orange County Royal Arch Chapter No. 73 and Triangle Royal Arch Chapter No. 155 each added two new members to their rolls.

**The Cryptic Degrees** were conferred on Wednesday September 19, 2007 at the San Diego Scottish Rite Center by San Diego Council of Cryptic Masons No. 23. and Helix Council of Cryptic Masons No. 58.

Helix Council No. 58 conferred the Royal Master Degree, and San Diego Council 23 conferred the Select Master Degree.

San Diego Council No. 23 Greeted three new

members, Helix Council No 58 Greeted 4 new members and Orange County Council No. 14 Greeted 2. There was a total of 9 new Cryptic Masons Greeted.

**The Orders of the Temple** were conferred on Saturday September 22, 2007 at the San Diego Scottish Rite Center commencing at 9 am. San Diego Commandery No. 25 conferred the Illustrious Order of the Red Cross; Riverside Commandery No. 28 conferred the Mediterranean Pass and the Order of Malta; and St. Bernard Commandery No. 23 of San Bernardino confer the Order of the Temple.

There was a total of 15 Companions Knighted at this event.

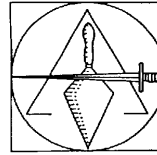
