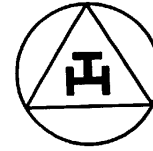
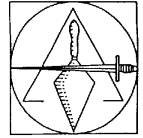
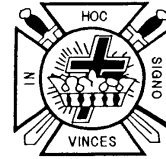

This 4th of July our country will celebrate the 232nd anniversary of our Declaration of Independence. Eleven years after the adoption of the Declaration of Independence, the supreme law of the United States of America, the U.S. Constitution was adopted by U.S. Congress.

The second paragraph of the Declaration of Independence reads:

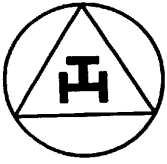

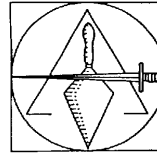

Illustrious Companion Fred Kleyn, Inspector, CM Arch 16, informed me that he will be conducting a Cryptic Mason ritual seminar on Saturday, 30 August at the Masonic Center in Escondido. As many of you may recall, we did this last year and the seminar was well received. Additionally, it is an excellent way to prepare for our upcoming degrees on September 24<sup>th</sup>. Officers and cast members will need to attend, but the seminar is open to all Cryptic Masons. If you haven't seen the degrees for a while or if you just received your degrees, I highly recommend you attend. It will be a morning event and we are usually finished before noon. As more information becomes available I will pass it on.

In preparation for our upcoming degrees I have include an explanation of the two degrees we will confer.

**Royal Master**

A Degree emphasizing the lessons of patience and fortitude. The Degree centers around the Fellowcraft Masons who were artificers fabricating the fittings and furniture of the Temple. It is unusual in that the first part of the Degree depicts events taking place before the death of the Grand Master Hiram Abif, and the last part depicts events occurring after his death.

**Select Master**

A Degree emphasizing the lessons of devotion and zeal. The Degree centers on the construction and furnishing of a Secret Vault beneath the Sanctum Sanctorum of the Temple, and the deposition of those secrets pertaining to the Craft by the three ancient Grand Masters of the Craft. This Degree bridges the events surrounding the concealment and loss of the Ineffable Word and the events leading to the recover of the Word in the Royal Arch Degree. The presiding body is a Council, and the presiding officer is a Master (titled Illustrious).
