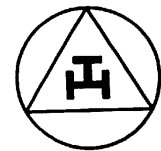
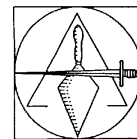
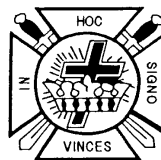

The Orders of the Temple will be conferred on Saturday October 9th at the San Diego Scottish Center commencing at 9 am. Greetings Companions:

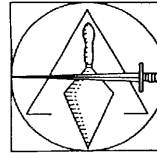
